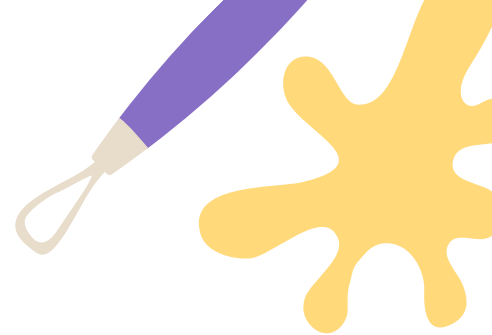


Frequently Asked QUESTIONS:



Q: When does registration open and close?

A: All camps will open for registration on March 5th, 2025 at 9:30 AM. Camp registration closes the Wednesday before each week at 12 PM or once full. We highly recommend registering early.

Q: What age does my child have to be for Summer Camp?

A: MHAC accepts children ages 6–13 for Summer Camp enrollment. Children younger than 6 or older than 13 will not be enrolled.

Q: Does the Mable House Arts Center offer before and after care?

A: Unfortunately at this time, we do not offer before and/or after care. If you choose to sign up for camp, the time is from 9:00am to 4:30pm. **Morning campers can be dropped off no earlier than 8:45 am** – the doors will not be open until then. **Afternoon campers cannot be dropped off any earlier than 12:45pm. Campers must be picked up at or before 12:30pm (morning camps) or 4:30pm (afternoon camp).**

Q: Do you allow drop-in campers and will camp registration fees be prorated if I register my camper after the program has started?

A: We do not allow drop in days for campers. The camp program is based off of the week. Due to limited registration spaces, we do not allow same week registration. Registration ends the Friday before at 12pm.

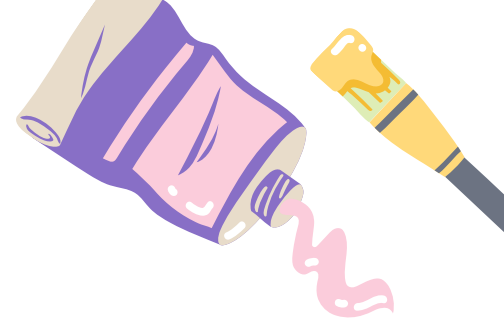
Q: How do I request a refund for my child's camp?

A: The Mable House Art Center is able to issue refunds up to 7 days before the initial day of your camp. To request a refund please call the front office at (770) 819-6735. Cancellations requested beyond that 7 day period require medical documentation, to warrant a full refund.

Q: How do I drop off and pick up my child?

A: For the safety of your child, we ask that parents walk in the building to drop off and pick up your child. Check-in on Mondays will take place in front of our gallery. **Remember to bring your ID for picking up your child.** Anyone not authorized on your paperwork to pick up will not be allowed to leave with your child. If you need to change to the authorization at any point during camp, call us at 770-819-6735 and we will let you know the steps to do that.

Frequently Asked QUESTIONS:



Q: What should I do if I am running late?

A: Give us a call at 770-819-6735 as soon as you know you will be late. Excessive late pick-ups will result in the camper be dismissed from the program.

Q: I've added my child to a waitlist, when will I be notified of an opening?

A: MHAC programs are first come, first serve. Those that have signed up to be on a waitlist will be contacted by front office staff in numerical order if a spot opens up.

Q: Do you provide lunch?

A: No. While we provide supervision during lunch we do not provide snacks or lunch of any kind. We ask that campers bring a ready to eat, non-microwavable lunch, two snacks, and water bottle. We are a nut free facility.

Q: What should my child wear?

A: Art gets messy! Make sure your child is wearing comfortable clothes that they can get messy and be active in. We ask that shoes be closed-toed as well.

Q: Who teaches camps?

A: All counselors are seasonal employees of Cobb County Government and have been background checked. The instructors and assistants have experience in education, visual arts and performing arts.
