Pottery Freestyle is an instructor free open studio style class. Students registering for this class must have pottery knowledge and have previously taken pottery at the Mable House Arts Center. Students must be able to work independently. MHAC staff will load and fire kilns weekly. Students will have access to the pottery studio on **FRIDAYS from 11 am - 3 pm ONLY**. Class fee covers studio usage, 1 bag of clay, bucket glazes and firings.



*****POTTERY STUDIO REMINDERS*****

The pottery studio is only available for students during scheduled class time and during open studio. Students with an instructor led class may arrive(evening classes)/stay(morning classes) up to **two hours** after/before class time.

Make sure you leave a .25" bleed space on the ends of all pieces! We want to preserve our kiln shelves as much a possible. Repeat offenders of pieces sticking to kiln shelves will be required to help clean them.

THE LAST WEEK FOR WET CLAY WORK IS FEBRUARY 14TH

Outside clay and glazes are not encouraged, unless given approval by instructor and studio manager. We fire to cone 6 for glaze and cone 05 for bisque.

Please clean up after yourself. A mop and bucket are available for you.
