ALL LEVELS WHEEL

*****POTTERY STUDIO REMINDERS*****

The pottery studio is only available for students during scheduled class time and during open studio. Students with an instructor led class may arrive(evening classes)/stay(morning classes) up to two hours after/before class time.

Make sure you leave a .25" bleed space on the ends of all pieces! We want to preserve our kiln shelves as much a possible. Repeat offenders of pieces sticking to kiln shelves will be required to help clean them.

THE LAST WEEK FOR WET CLAY WORK IS MARCH 20TH

Outside clay and glazes are not encouraged, unless given approval by instructor and studio manager. We fire to cone 6 for glaze and cone 05 for bisque. We will not fire to different temperatures unless you have enough pieces to fill an entire kiln.

Please clean up after yourself. If you make a large mess, a mop and bucket are available for you.

We will continue using the grid method during the fourth & final sessions, but you will recreate an image using patterns in each block of the grid instead of using just lines. Don't forget about shading! We will use a pen to create a variation of shading for each block.
