

Mable House Acrylic Painting Class

Objective

This is an all levels class exploring the use of the acrylic painting medium. We will be starting out at learning the basics of this medium and creating various kinds of paintings. We will relax, go slow and enjoy the act of painting at any level.

Materials: all can be obtained from Hobby Lobby or Michael's

Canvas Boards or Canvases: Generally you will need either 9 x 12 or 11 x 14 canvas sizes.

Paints: There are Acrylic Paint kits of complete colors at Michaels or Hobby Lobby. These are reasonable and you can explore what your own personal palette will be. If you wish to buy individual paints you will need these:

Titanium White	Ivory Black	Cadmium Red	Alizarion Crimson	Dioxine Purple
Ultramarine Blue	Cerulean Blue	Turquoise	Veridian Green	Light Green
Yellow Ochre	Burnt Sienna	Raw Umber		

(always get an extra tube of White and Yellow – they go fast)

You will need a palette. I use A plastic Palette Paper holder from Masterson Enterprise or from Masters Art Products. It has a blue plastic sealable top which keeps your paints intact during travel. The disposable palette paper that fits inside is Strathmore Palette Paper. I use only white palette paper.

OR you can get 500 plastic or Styrofoam plates and use them. They are disposable and do the trick.

A series of brushes: A number 10 filbert and flat, a number 6 filbert and flat, a number 3 o4 2 filbert and flat. You will need a good fan brush, any size.

Lots of Water Cans: please bring more than one. Clean water can be important while we paint.

Acrylic Medium (Liquitex makes a good one and it last forever – it also softens your paints, allowing them not to dry so quickly)

A spray bottle

Paper towels
